
Established in 1979 by Roger Stephenson, the practice is nationally known, Manchester based with a portfolio of work in the North West of England and a number of British Cities.










Part of the second phase of development, the world class orchestral hall is an acoustically isolated box within a box, providing a 484 seat capacity venue.















With local and national property developer Urban Splash, we have created 31 canal-side loft apartments; some of the largest in Manchester, set over seven floors.
